1. **Norwegian Wood by Haruki Murakami** - Inspired by The Beatles' song from their album "Rubber Soul."
2. **I Believe in a Thing Called Love by Maurene Goo** - Sharing its title with the song by The Darkness.
3. **Wuthering Heights by Emily Brontë** - Kate Bush famously sang a song with this title.
4. **Go Tell It on the Mountain by James Baldwin** - Named after the traditional Christmas spiritual.
5. **Somewhere Only We Know by Maurene Goo** - Title shared with the Keane song.
6. **Don't You Forget About Me by Kate Karyus Quinn** - Borrowing the title from the Simple Minds song featured in "The Breakfast Club."
7. **The Summer We Crossed Europe in the Rain by Kazuo Ishiguro** - Also the title of a song by Stacey Kent, for which Ishiguro wrote the lyrics.
8. **Heart-Shaped Box by Joe Hill** - The title is from a Nirvana song.
9. **Linger by Maggie Stiefvater** - Sharing its name with The Cranberries' hit song.
10. **Since You've Been Gone by Rainbow Rowell** - Echoing the song by Powderfinger or The Darkness, depending on interpretation.
11. **Jesse's Girl by Miranda Kenneally** - Inspired by the Rick Springfield song.

12. **Love on the Brain by Ali Hazelwood** - Sharing its title with Rihanna's song.
13. **"Born to Run" by Christopher McDougall** - Shares its name with Bruce Springsteen's famous song.
14. **"There There" by Tommy Orange** - In direct reference to Radiohead's There, There.
